Supply List

- One pad of 18"X 24" cheap white sketch paper

- Ten to twelve sheets of 30"X 22" good quality, cold press, drawing paper such as:

140 lb watercolor paper2 pr 3 ply Strathmore drawing paperPrintmaking paper (Stonehenge, Arches, or Rives BFK)

- Notebook and pen
- Drawing board to accommodate your paper size
- Clips (to attach your paper to your board)

*If you have a favorite drawing paper, please bring it *If you want to work larger or smaller, that is fine

- Soft, vine charcoal (large and small sticks)
- Compressed charcoal sticks (such as Alphacolor or Cretacolor)
- Black and white Nu-Pastel sticks
- Black and white Conte Crayons
- Black lumber crayon (Home Depot or Ace/Miners)
- 6B charcoal pencils
- Soft graphite pencils and sticks
- Kneaded eraser (soft)
- Hard eraser (such as Magic Rub, Factis)
- Sand paper (fine, medium and course)
- Soft cloths or rags
- Paper towels (Viva or blue shop towels)

- 1" masking tape and 2" blue painters tape
- Small bucket for water
- Black and White gesso
- Cheap plastic trays and plastic cups/bowls (a few of each)
- Xacto knife with #11 blade and a sandpad, or a pencil sharpener
- 2" or 4" sponge rollers (2 of either size)
- Two 2" cheap house painting brushes
- Rubber gloves
- Dust masks
- Matte spray fix

* You may also bring pastel, acrylic, watercolor, ink and mixed media (including collage). If you are going to bring any of these, please bring all the supplies you will need to work with these mediums.
