

Types of Volunteers

- **Art After Dark Volunteer:** A volunteer who comes to SLOMA once per month for Art After Dark every first Friday of the month from 6PM to 9PM. Duties include:
 - Helping with setup and takedown of the food and wine tables
 - Pouring wine for the visitors if over 21
 - Keeping an eye on crowds and ensuring that the artwork remains safe
 - Refilling food platters as needed, and end-of-night cleaning
- **Front Desk Volunteer:** A volunteer who sits at the front desk in shifts of one to one and a half hours during the weekend. Duties include:
 - Greeting visitors and answering their questions
 - Making sales in the gift shop
 - Keeping an eye on the galleries to ensure art is not touched or disturbed
 - Answering the phone
- **Facility Assistant:** A volunteer who does light maintenance of the facility in shifts of one to two hours during open hours at any time during the week as suits their schedule. Duties include:
 - Sweeping floors
 - Emptying trash
 - Cleaning door glass and dusting shelves
 - Other light maintenance duties as needed
- **Gallery Assistant:** A volunteer who helps setup for exhibitions on Mondays and Tuesdays during the first part of the month. Some experience preferred, availability on Mondays and Tuesdays during the first half of each month required. Duties include:
 - Patching and painting walls
 - Assisting in hanging artworks
 - Wrapping and labeling sold artworks from the previous exhibition
- **Promotions Volunteer:** A volunteer who takes promotional materials such as posters and flyers and distributes them in well-visited locations once or twice per month. Duties include:
 - Effectively placing materials where people can see them in varied locations around the city and Cal Poly campus
 - Posting SLOMA events accurately to online community calendars
 - Looking for and compiling arts groups for outreach
 - Calling participants in ArtWays and gathering information about their interest in becoming more involved with the museum
 - Folding mailings and assembling them correctly into their envelopes
 - Addressing, sealing, and stamping each envelope for mailing
- **Volunteer Docent:** A volunteer who is trained in Visual Thinking Strategies and uses them to help visitors interpret the artworks in the museum for shifts of one to three hours on a weekly basis. Duties include:
 - Giving tours to visitors
 - Helping them develop their ability to critically think about art
