San Luis Obispo Museum of Art Launches 2nd Saturdays Program with Art-making Events for the Whole Family

SAN LUIS OBISPO, Calif., July 7, 2021— Invite the entire family to unleash their inner artists with San Luis Obispo Museum of Art (SLOMA)'s 2nd Saturdays program. Complementing the museum's current exhibitions, the monthly series will feature creative art-making activities for all ages and experience levels.

Starting on Saturday, July 12, the 2nd Saturdays launches with an artistic activity corresponding with *Atmospheres Deep*, the museum's current multimedia exhibition exploring ecology and environmentalism. "Gallery on the Go" art kits will be provided free to all participants and will contain paintable ocean-themed postcards with Spira algae pigment to be used for the watercolor painting activity. The activity encourages people to think creatively about the use of ocean byproducts and sustainable artistic materials.

"We're excited to encourage our community to explore their artistic abilities with us during 2nd Saturdays," said Leann Standish, Executive Director of SLOMA. "I can't wait to be around people having fun and making art outdoors!".

2nd Saturdays takes place from 11 am to 1 pm the second Saturday of every month on the lawn outside of SLOMA's Mission Plaza double doors. The event is free and open to all.
