



### **Spring 2026 Internship Description**

The San Luis Obispo Museum of Art (SLOMA) seeks one undergraduate or graduate intern to join our team this Spring. This internship position provides an opportunity for currently enrolled or recent graduates to gain experience working in the professional setting of a museum while also developing and exploring their own unique interests. Interns assist with exhibition preparation, visitor services, collections, and social media management, all while working closely with SLOMA's curatorial and education teams. Interns are encouraged to develop projects based on their own areas of study and interest related to art education and engagement in the museum context. A housing and transportation stipend of \$100 per week will be distributed bi-weekly for the duration of the internship.

The internship program will start on Monday, April 27<sup>th</sup> and run for 14 weeks, through the end of July. Interns are expected to work 6-8 hours a week. Weekly hours are flexible depending on student schedules, required hours for credit, and standing travel plans. \*Interns are required to attend weekly staff meetings, Thursdays from 10am – 11am.
